First Friday Adoration will be this Friday, February 2, beginning with Exposition at 6:30 p.m and, if we get enough committed adorers, will continue until 10:30 p.m., ending with Benediction. There will still be Mass that morning at 9:00 followed by an hour of Adoration. I'll be at the main church entrance after the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses this Sunday, January 28, to take sign-ups for the evening hours of Adoration and answer any questions you might have about Adoration and/or First Friday/Saturday Devotions. Hours of devotion open for commitment currently are: 6:30-7:30 p.m., 7:30-8:30 p.m., 8:30-9:30 p.m., and 9:30-10:30 p.m. We are in need of at least five more committed adorers, bringing our total now to at least eight. Being a committed adorer means once you sign-up for an hour, that hour will be the hour you'll be adoring every month on the first Friday. Reminders will go out the weekend prior, and I'll put out an email asking if anyone needs a substitute so arrangements can be made well in advance if that need exists. If you need to or would like to move your hour at some point, that can be arranged, and we may need some folks to change hours once we expand the hours of Adoration again to ensure they're all filled. If you're hesitant to commit to one hour at this time, please do stop by and visit Our Lord at any time of your choosing during the Holy Hours and spend some time with the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.
