Friday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, will mark the start of a 40 hours devotion leading up to Corpus Christi Sunday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Sign-ups for Adoration during the 40 hours devotion will begin May 20<sup>th</sup>. There will be a sign-up board in the parish hall which will include a schedule of special devotions to be observed during the 40 hours. Committed adorers are encouraged to sign-up for and keep their normal hours, or change up as they'd like during this special observance as all hours will be open for sign-ups. *Normally scheduled Adoration will resume in July.* Our celebration of the Body of Christ will conclude with a Eucharistic procession that will begin in Bridge Park Sunday afternoon (time TBA) and conclude on the parish grounds where Father hopes to have at least 3 altars and no more than 7 altars set up along our route around the grounds. ### **Our Lady of Fatima Pilgrim Virgin Statue**

As many may remember last August I participated in a pilgrimage to Fatima Portugal for the 100th Anniversary of Our Lady's Apparitions to the Shepherd Children of Fatima. As a part of her apparitions Our Lady asked that a Pilgrim Virgin Statue be made in accord with her image as she appeared to the children so that she could visit and bless those throughout the world who are unable to make pilgrimage to Fatima. As a part of this message many parishes throughout the world have their very own Pilgrim Virgin Statue programs. Inspired by this request and these examples I wanted to bring this blessing to the families of our Parish by bringing back a statue of Our Lady of Fatima from Fatima for our own Pilgrim Virgin Statue Program. Many signal graces and favors have been obtained for families through their prayer requests and intentions that have been asked of Our Lady from her time of visitations. The month of May celebrates Our Lady of Fatima's feast day on the 13th of May and the month of May is dedicated to Mary. As a part of this next Sunday we will have sign-ups for one week visits of Our Lady of Fatima to the homes of families of Saint Mary Mother of God. Each family will be able to take home Our Lady in her traveling shrine on Sundays and asked to return her to Saint Mary's on the following Saturday. A sign up sheet will be available beginning after the Sunday Masses next Sunday the 20th of May with the first week of visitation beginning Sunday May 27th. We are at the end of another successful academic year in campus ministry at WCU. In addition to Sunday Mass and catechesis, and Wednesday fellowship, we were also able to offer four different weekly Bible studies this semester, participated in the diocesan "Give Your Heart Away" service weekend, and took a dozen students on a camping retreat in the Smoky Mountain National Park. Later this month we will be sponsoring half a dozen student leaders in evangelization and small group facilitation training at a four day workshop at the Catholic Conference Center in Hickory.

This year we have also been able to make an impact beyond our usual student population at WCU. We were able to offer RCIA to a student at Southwestern Community College who was baptized this Easter, as well help prepare a Western faculty member to be received into the Church at St. Eugene's in Asheville.

Who knows what the next year will bring? WCU is hosting eight different Freshman Orientation fairs over the month of June, and campus ministry will have a table at each one, to meet the incoming students and their parents.

We couldn't have the presence on campus that we do without the dedicated support of the St. Mary's community. Some of you have recently received our spring appeal letter.
