Friday, June 1 will mark the start of a 40 hours devotion leading up

to Corpus Christi Sunday, June 3. Sign-ups for Adoration during the 40 hours devotion will begin May 20. There is a sign-up board in front of the parish hall which includes a schedule of special devotions to be observed during the 40 hours. Committed adorers are encouraged to sign-up for and keep their normal hours, or change up as they'd like during this special observance as all hours will be open for sign-ups. *Normally scheduled Adoration will resume in July.*

Our celebration of the Body of Christ will conclude with a Eucharistic Procession that will begin in Bridge Park Sunday afternoon at 3:00 p.m. and conclude on the parish grounds where ***Father hopes to have at least 3 altars and no more than 7 altars*** set up along our route around the grounds.
