An important cut-off is approaching. Before being selected for diaconate formation, a man has to complete the two-year Lay Ecclesial Ministry program offered by the diocese. He's longing for each of us as he lies exposed upon the altar; longing for us to share but one hour with him our requests, sorrows, joys, concerns, fears, and thanks and praise.
