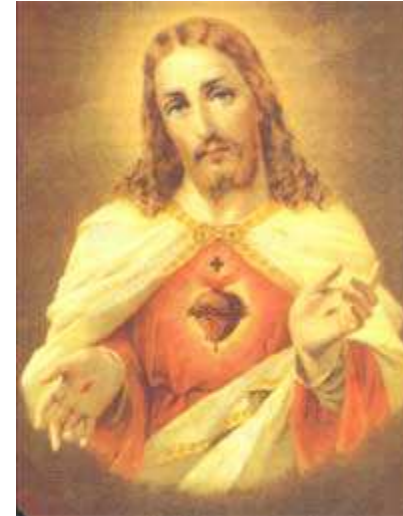
The Small-Group Bible Study will hold an introductory session in the Fellowship Hall on Saturday, June 23rd, following the 9:00 am Mass until around noon.
