Happy Thanksgiving!

Happy Thanksgiving to everyone! I want to express a special thank you to the Knights of Columbus for helping to organize and set up for our Parish Thanksgiving Dinner. May this be a blessed time to pause and reflect on the blessings we have received from God the Father through His Son, Jesus Christ, especially as we gather with friends and family. I am truly thankful for all of you as my/our parish family. I have been welcomed into your families in many ways and have received abundant blessings in many varied ways. So I offer through the words of St. Paul this prayer for all of you this Thanksgiving. *"I give thanks to my God at every remembrance of you, praying always with joy in my every prayer for all of you, because of your partnership for the gospel from the first day until now. I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus. It is right that I should think this way about all of you, because I hold you in my heart, you who are all partners with me in grace...For God is my witness, how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus. Advent a Time of Silence and Preparation:

We will hear from John the Baptist in our first week of Advent to prepare the way of the Lord. John is in the desert away from the noise of the cities. During advent Mon., Thurs., Fri., there will be a time of Adoration from 7am-8am with Liturgy of the Hours Morning Prayer at 7am and then Adoration again from 6pm-7pm with Evening Prayer at 6pm. The Liturgy of the Hours is the continuous prayer of the Church and Adoration of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist is the extension of the fruits of the Mass. Adoration will be conducted through simple exposition and reposition without solemn exposition, benediction, and incense.
