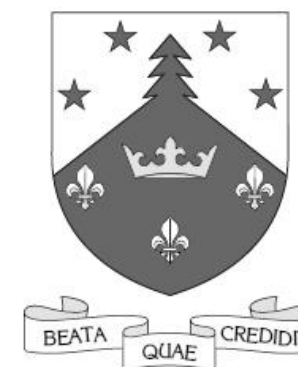

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parish Family,

This weekend I mourn the death of a good elder Priest friend and mentor, Fr. Con Cronin, SPS. He died in Monkstown, County Cork, Ireland on Tuesday, the day when the Gospel reminds us of what happened the day Jesus asked Peter to step out of the boat and come to him across the water. After he walked on top of the waters of a storm that threatened to sink the boat Peter and the other Apostles were in. Jesus called out to them, saying, 'Courage! It is I! Do not be afraid.' When faced with frightening situations, if we trust Jesus, we will walk over that storm not minding the cost. Because our eyes are focused on Jesus, who invites us to take that step. If we take our eyes off Jesus, we sink.

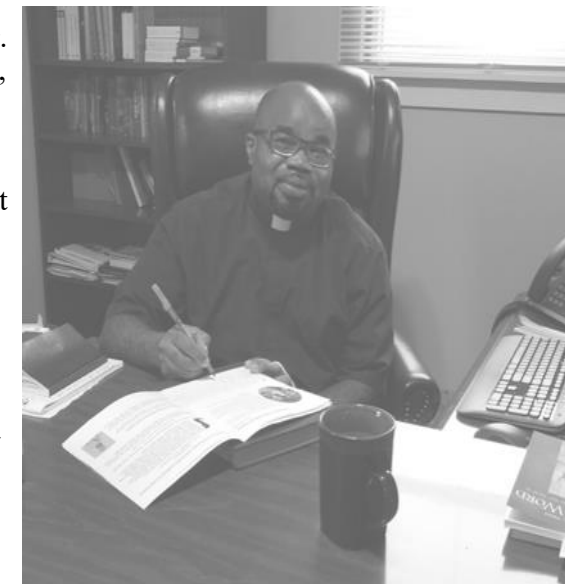
Locals in the area said that Fr. Con Cronin the 72-year-old priest pushed the Parish Secretary to safety when a bus veered towards them in Monkstown, a village in County Cork, on Aug. 3. The bus driver, Mark Wills, 52, also died. *The Irish Times* reported that he is believed to have lost control of the vehicle after suffering a medical trauma.

Fr. Con Cronin who died a hero at 72 years, was a missionary in Africa for 25 years, many of those years spent in Nigeria before returning to Ireland in 2004. When I arrived in Ireland in 2006 for studies, he welcomed me to his family home in the Borlin valley near Bantry in County Cork during my first holiday in the late fall of that year. He was also Parochial vicar or Curate in the Harbour Parishes of Passage West and Monkstown, where I also visited him a couple of times. He inspired everyone with his missionary commitment, humor and generosity. I am saddened by his death but proud of his Christian heroism. No greater love a man or woman can have than to lay down his life for another. My condolences, thoughts and prayers go to Fr. Con's family, his wide circle of friends, parishioners, and his fellow priests in the St. Patrick's Missionary Society, Kiltegan, with whom I served with for four years, and the priests of the Diocese of Cork and Ross. *Cf. During the week of August 16th-23rd, two handmade wooden kneelers will be at our parish. Please take a moment to pray on the kneelers for the Deacons. There will be prayer cards and journals in which you can write messages of encouragement and well wishes. The kneelers and journals will travel to other parishes in the coming months and then will be given to the men at their ordination. Desde el escritorio del pastor

Querida familia parroquial,

Este fin de semana lamento la muerte de un buen sacerdote amigo y mentor, el P. Con Cronin, SPS. Murió en Monkstown, County Cork, Irlanda el martes, el día en que el Evangelio nos recuerda lo que sucedió día en que Jesús le pidió a Pedro que saliera del bote y se acercara a él al otro lado del agua. Después de caminar sobre las aguas de una tormenta que amenazaba con hundir la barca en la que estaban Pedro y los otros apóstoles. Jesús los llamó, diciendo: "¡Ánimo! ¡Esto soy yo! No tengas miedo." Cuando nos enfrentamos a situaciones aterradoras, si confiamos en Jesús, caminaremos sobre esa tormenta sin importar el costo. Porque nuestros ojos están enfocados en Jesús, quien nos invita a dar ese paso. quitamos nuestros ojos de Jesús, nos hundimos.

Los lugareños de la zona dijeron que el P. Con Cronin, el sacerdote de años, empujó al secretario parroquial a un lugar seguro cuando un autobús viró hacia ellos en Monkstown, una aldea en el condado de Cork, el 3 de agosto. El conductor del autobús, Mark Wills, de 52 años, también murió. The Irish Times informó que se cree que perdió el control del vehículo después de sufrir un trauma médico.

P. Con Cronin, que murió como un héroe a los 72 años, fue misionero en África durante 25 años, muchos de esos años los pasó en Nigeria antes de regresar a Irlanda en 2004. Cuando llegué a Irlanda en 2006 para estudiar, me dio la bienvenida a su casa familiar. en el valle de Borlin cerca de Bantry en el condado de Cork durante mis primeras vacaciones a fines del otoño de ese año. También fue vicario parroquial o Curate en las parroquias del puerto de Passage West y Monkstown, donde también lo visité un par de veces. Inspiró a todos con su compromiso misionero, humor y generosidad. Me entristece su muerte pero me enorgullece su heroísmo cristiano. No hay amor más grande que un hombre o una mujer pueda tener que dar su vida por otro. Mi más sentido pésame, pensamientos y oraciones para el P. La familia de Con, su amplio círculo de amigos, feligreses y sus compañeros sacerdotes en la Sociedad Misionera de San Patricio, Kiltegan, con quien serví durante cuatro años, y los sacerdotes de la Diócesis de Cork y Ross. *Cf. 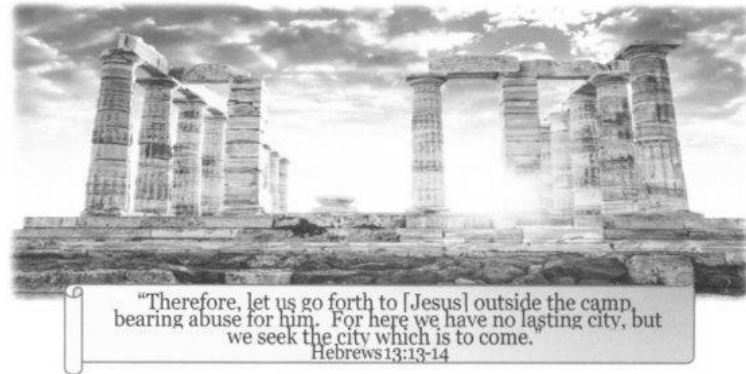

Fr. Walter “Ray” Williams – is from Alabama and an adult convert to the Catholic faith. As a young man, he was an English teacher and lived in Nepal near Kathmandu where he hiked, worked and taught at a British English language school for five years. He is fluent in Nepalese. He left Nepal during a time of violent revolution and traveled to Austria where he spent a couple of years teaching English to Jewish refugees from the Soviet Union. He returned to the States in order to be with his dying mother and was received into the Church during that time.
After a few years in the Church, Fr. Ray discerned a calling to the priesthood. He studied at the North American College in the Vatican City and attended the University of St. Thomas Aquinas [Angelicum] before returning to the Diocese of Charlotte as a parish priest.
He is known to many in western North Carolina, as a former pastor, confessor and visiting priest. He was chaplain to the Western Carolina University Catholic Campus Ministry for many years and led hikes through the Smoky Mountains and took the opportunity to challenge young men and women to lead meaningful and purposeful lives and to question the assumptions of modern values in favor of something more enduring and ultimately eternal.
Fr. Ray’s discussion of St. Paul’s letter to the Hebrews, “For here we have no lasting city,” is a reminder that we are pilgrims in this world and that we should fix our eyes on that Heavenly City beyond even Mount Everest, where we hope to find our enduring home, where, as it is written, “what no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him” (1 Cor. 2:9)
