

From the Pastor's Desk

The time Jeremiah prophesied in Israel was a time of religious and moral crises. The political rulers and religious leaders were deep in corruption and injustice. The poor were neglected and oppressed. The true God was no longer worshipped with seriousness. Worship of foreign gods became a common practice. In the first reading, Jeremiah confronted the rulers and leaders for their derailment: “Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the flock of my pasture … Therefore, thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, against the shepherds who shepherd my people: You have scattered my sheep and driven them away. You have not cared for them, but I will take care to punish your evil deeds” (Jeremiah 23:1-2).



The first reading, accurately, captures the disturbing situation today in crises ridden countries. The rulers in the crises ridden countries destroy and scatter the people and drive them away. Hundreds of thousands of people are dying of sickness, hunger, poverty, and violence. Thousands of people are fleeing their homelands, and many are dying across deserts, in seas, in captivity, and in detentions. Thousands of people are forced to surrender themselves to the humiliation of human traffickers and the humiliation of seeking refugee status and asylum status in foreign lands. We continue to pray and wait for God’s promise: “I myself will gather the remnant of my flock from all the lands … and bring them back to their folds; there they shall be fruitful and multiply. I will raise up shepherds for them who will shepherd them so that they need no longer fear or be terrified; none shall be missing” (Jeremiah 23:3-4).

We pray to have religious, economic, and political shepherds who will be a fulfillment of Jeremiah’s prophecy; the days when righteous and just rulers reign and govern wisely, and when the people will dwell in security (Jeremiah 23:6).

We pray to have religious, political, and economic shepherds who will be “Repairers of Broken Walls, and Restorers of Streets and Dwellings” (Isaiah 58:12); shepherds who have the mind of Christ; shepherds who break down the dividing wall of enmity and establish peace; shepherds who preach peace to those far off and peace to those who are near

Desde Escritorio del Pastor

El tiempo que Jeremías profetizó en Israel fue un tiempo de crisis religiosas y morales. Los gobernantes políticos y los líderes religiosos estaban sumidos en la corrupción y la injusticia. Los pobres eran abandonados y oprimidos. El Dios verdadero ya no era adorado con seriedad. La adoración de dioses extranjeros se convirtió en una práctica común. En la primera lectura, Jeremías confrontó a los gobernantes y líderes por su descarrilamiento: "¡Ay de los pastores que destruyen y dispersan el rebaño de mi prado... Por eso, así dice el Señor, Dios de Israel, contra los pastores que apacentan a mi pueblo: Has dispersado mis ovejas y las has ahuyentado. No te has preocupado de ellos, pero yo me encargaré de castigar tus malas obras" (Jeremías 23:1-2).



La primera lectura, con precisión, capta la inquietante situación actual en los países asolados por las crisis. Los gobernantes de los países asolados por las crisis destruyen y dispersan a la gente y la expulsan. Cientos de miles de personas están muriendo de enfermedades, hambre, pobreza y violencia. Miles de personas están huyendo de sus países de origen, y muchas están muriendo a través de desiertos, mares, cautiverio y detenciones. Miles de personas se ven obligadas a entregarse a la humillación de los traficantes de personas y a la humillación de solicitar la condición de refugiado y asilo en tierras extranjeras. Seguimos orando y esperando la promesa de Dios: "Yo mismo reuniré el resto de mi rebaño de todas las tierras... y los devuelva a sus rediles; allí fructificarán y se multiplicarán. Les levantare pastores que los pastoreen, para que ya no tengan que temer ni aterrorizarse; no faltará ninguno" (Jeremías 23:3-4).

Oramos para tener pastores religiosos, económicos y políticos que sean el cumplimiento de la profecía de Jeremías; los días en que los gobernantes rectos y justos reinan y gobiernan sabiamente, y cuando el pueblo morará en seguridad (Jeremías 23:6).

Oramos para tener pastores religiosos, políticos y económicos que sean "reparadores de muros rotos y restauradores de calles y viviendas" (Isaías 58:12); pastores que tienen la mente de Cristo; pastores que derriban el muro divisorio de la enemistad y establecen la paz; pastores que predicen la paz a los que están lejos y la paz a los que están cerca.
