## Deacon Matt's Reflections on the National Eucharistic Congress

I spent five days last week at the 10th National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. And I was not alone. Depending on the day of the week, somewhere between 40,000 and 70,000 of my fellow Catholics were in attendance, making this the largest gathering of Catholics in the United States in decades. This was the first National Eucharistic Congress to take place in America since 1941. (The next one is scheduled for 2033, when the Church will celebrate the 2000th anniversary of our Redemption). It was the culmination of a three-year Eucharistic Revival instituted by the USCCB in response to survey data indicating a decline among Catholics in belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.



In Indianapolis last week, faith in — and love for — the Eucharist was center stage. Literally. The first Revival session on Wednesday night concluded with a Holy Hour in Lucas Oil Stadium with 40,000 adorers kneeling on hard concrete floors for an hour while Bishop Andrew Cozzens, chair of the National Eucharistic Congress board, led us in prayer. It was magnificent. It was inspiring. And the same thing happened every night of the Congress, with different priests and bishops presiding.

During the day, I bounced back and forth between various talks and liturgies. Many big-name Catholic speakers were on hand — Scott Hahn, Bishop Robert Barron, Fr. Mike Schmitz, Sister Josephine Garrett, Jonathan Roumie, Chris Stephanic, and so many others. But none of them were the star of the show. The big attraction was Jesus, always, thanks to the efforts of the event organizers to keep the liturgy front and center.

One thing that impressed me about the Congress was the diversity of liturgical celebrations, with Masses celebrated not only in English, but also Spanish and Vietnamese. Masses were also offered in the Byzantine and Syro-Malabar Rites, as well as according to the 1962 Roman Missal. It was beautiful to see the Eucharist being celebrated by diverse cultures expressing our one faith in Jesus Christ, in unity with the Catholic Church under the leadership of the Holy Father. The Church's unity in the Eucharist was definitely a major theme of the event.

I confess, after the first full day of the Congress I was feeling a bit overwhelmed by the size of the crowd. At a luncheon hosted by Bishop Martin for attendees from the Diocese of Charlotte, I sat next to Dr. Mario Sacasa, Catholic therapist and host of the Always Hope podcast. Maybe it's because he's a therapist, but during our conversation, I confided in him that I had a problem. My exhaustion due to the crowds made me worry about the great multitude of the heavenly host described in Revelation. "I'm too much of an introvert," I said. "I don't know how I'll be able to manage heaven — God's just going to have to do something to fix me between now and then!"

But reflecting on my experience at the Congress, there were certain times when I did not feel overwhelmed or lost, even though I was surrounded by tens of thousands of people. It was during the Mass. It was during the Eucharistic Procession through downtown Indianapolis. It was during Adoration. At those times, we were not 50,000 people each going our own separate ways, seeing to our own affairs, concerned with our own pursuits. We were 50,000 people united in worship, each fulfilling his or her role as clergy, consecrated religious, or laity. We were 50,000 people united in love for Christ in the Eucharist. We were 50,000 people, but in those moments we were one. Those moments, for me, were a foretaste of heaven.

I received many consolations from God during my time at the Congress, but that was perhaps the biggest. And it left me convicted that for our Church to be truly united, the Eucharist must be at the center. It must be in practice what the Second Vatican Council says that it is, "the source and summit of the Christian life." The Eucharist is the beating heart of the Body of Christ. Tens of thousands of people were united in the rhythm of that heartbeat last week. May this be the start of a true revival of faith, hope and love in our nation, in the Church, and in the heart of each believer.

# Reflexiones del Diacono Mateo sobre el Congreso Eucarístico Nacional

La semana pasada pasé cinco días en el Décimo Congreso Eucarístico Nacional en Indianápolis. Y no estaba solo. Dependiendo del día de la semana, asistieron entre 40.000 y 70.000 de mis compañeros católicos, lo que convirtió esta en la reunión de católicos más grande en los Estados Unidos en décadas. Este fue el primer Congreso Eucarístico Nacional que tuvo lugar en América desde 1941 (el próximo está programado para 2033, cuando la Iglesia celebrará el 2000 aniversario de nuestra Redención). Fue la culminación de un Renacimiento Eucarístico de tres años instituido por la USCCB en respuesta a datos de encuestas que indicaban una disminución entre los católicos en la creencia en la Presencia Real de Jesús en la Eucaristía.



La semana pasada en Indianápolis, la fe y el amor por la Eucaristía fueron el centro del escenario. Literalmente. La primera sesión de avivamiento del miércoles por la noche concluyó con una Hora Santa en el estadio Lucas Oil con 40.000 adoradores arrodillados sobre duros pisos de concreto durante una hora mientras el obispo Andrew Cozzens, presidente de la junta del Congreso Eucarístico Nacional, nos guiaba en oración. Fue magnífico. Fue inspirador. Y lo mismo sucedió todas las noches del Congreso, presidido por diferentes sacerdotes y obispos.

Durante el día, iba y venía entre varios discursos y liturgias. Estuvieron presentes muchos oradores católicos de renombre: Scott Hahn, el obispo Robert Barron, el p. Mike Schmitz, la hermana Josephine Garrett, Jonathan Roumie, Chris Stephanic y muchos otros. Pero ninguno de ellos fue la estrella del espectáculo. La gran atracción fue Jesús, siempre, gracias a los esfuerzos de los organizadores del evento por mantener la liturgia al frente y al centro.

Una cosa que me impresionó del Congreso fue la diversidad de celebraciones litúrgicas, con misas celebradas no sólo en inglés, sino también en español y vietnamita. También se ofrecieron misas en los ritos bizantino y siro-malabar, así como según el Misal Romano de 1962. Fue hermoso ver la Eucaristía celebrada por diversas culturas expresando nuestra única fe en Jesucristo, en unidad con la Iglesia Católica bajo el liderazgo del Santo Padre. La unidad de la Iglesia en la Eucaristía fue sin duda un tema importante del evento.

Lo confieso, después del primer día completo de Congreso me sentí un poco abrumado por el tamaño de la multitud. En un almuerzo organizado por el obispo Martin para los asistentes de la Diócesis de Charlotte, me senté junto al Dr. Mario Sacasa, terapeuta católico y presentador del podcast Always Hope. Tal vez sea porque es terapeuta, pero durante nuestra conversación le confié que tenía un problema. Mi cansancio debido a las multitudes me hizo preocuparme por la gran multitud de las huestes celestiales descrita en el Apocalipsis. "Soy demasiado introvertido", dije. "No sé cómo podré manejar el cielo; ¡Dios simplemente tendrá que hacer algo para arreglarme de aquí a entonces!"

Pero al reflexionar sobre mi experiencia en el Congreso, hubo ciertos momentos en los que no me sentí abrumado ni perdido, a pesar de que estaba rodeado por decenas de miles de personas. Fue durante la Misa. Fue durante la Procesión Eucarística por el centro de Indianápolis. Fue durante la Adoración. En aquellos tiempos, no éramos 50.000 personas, cada una yendo por caminos separados, ocupándonos de nuestros propios asuntos, o preocupándonos de nuestras propias metas. Éramos 50.000 personas unidas en el culto, cada uno cumpliendo su rol de clérigo, religioso consagrado o laico. Éramos 50.000 personas unidas en el amor a Cristo en la Eucaristía. Éramos 50.000 personas, pero en esos momentos éramos uno. Esos momentos, para mí, fueron un anticipo del cielo.

Recibí muchos consuelos de Dios durante mi paso por el Congreso, pero ese fue quizás el más grande. Y me dejó convencido de que para que nuestra Iglesia esté verdaderamente unida, la Eucaristía debe estar en el centro. Debe ser en la práctica lo que dice el Concilio Vaticano II: "fuente y cumbre de la vida cristiana". La Eucaristía es el corazón palpitante del Cuerpo de Cristo. Decenas de miles de personas se unieron al ritmo de ese latido la semana pasada. Que este sea el comienzo de un verdadero renacimiento de la fe, la esperanza y el amor en nuestra nación, en la Iglesia y en el corazón de cada creyente.
